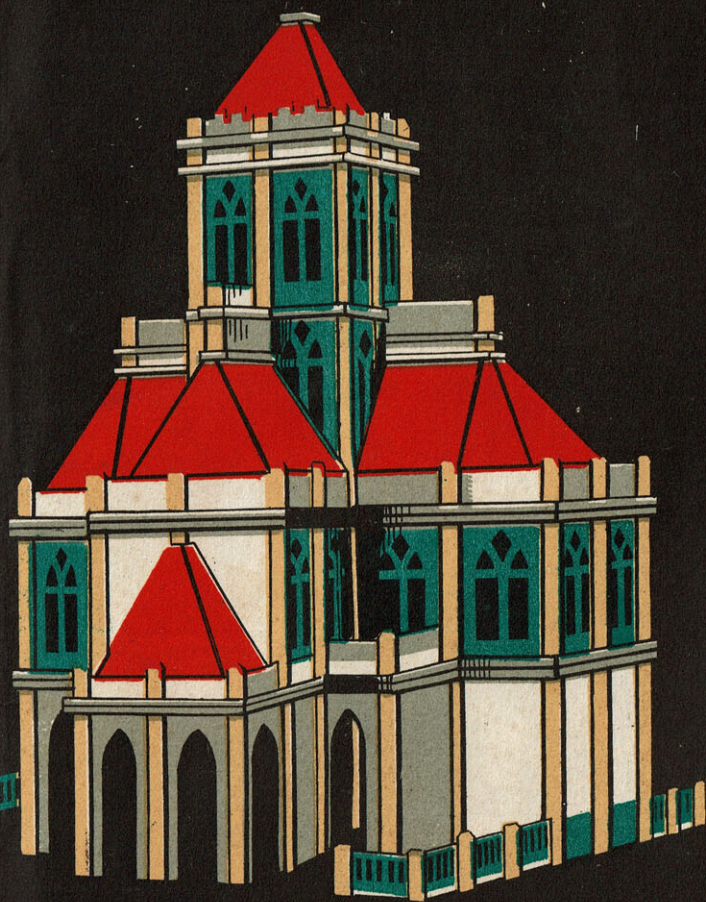
MOBACO № 3
